Equipment

They only use full size casino tables with full size roulette wheels. Similar quotes from other companies may be for a "fun pack" and half size plastic wheels. All chips are genuine casino chips, and not cheap plastic discs. There is nothing like the feel of heavy casino chips clinking against the velvety smooth baize.

This exciting alternative form of entertainment is suitable for: Parties, Weddings, Fund Raising, Grand Openings, Product Launches, Promotions, Corporate Functions, Themed Events, Summer Balls, Christmas & New Year and more!

The event is started by giving your guests **fun money** to exchange at the table for casino chips. They then bet on the games and either win or lose.

At the end of the night the lucky person with the most money wins.

The prizes are supplied by the host and can range from a bottle of champagne to a DVD player or holiday, depending on budget.

This event can be used on the same basis to **raise money for charity**, whereby the players buy in for their chips, for example £5 could buy them £100 worth of fun money for chips or perhaps the casino is included in the ticket price for the event.

They will run a fun casino for you anywhere within

London and the Home Counties.



Roulette

First you exchange your fun money for roulette colour chips you then place your chips on the table. The dealer will spin the ball. When the ball stops the dealer will remove all losing bets and pay all winning bets.



Wheel of Fortune

Wheel of Fortune is an easy game to play. The wheel has 7 different outcomes you can bet on. Place your bet on your choice or choices you think will win. The wheel is spun, and you will be paid out according to the result of where the pointer lands.



Blackjack

Blackjack is a relatively simple game. (Similar to **Pontoon**)

Each player is dealt two cards face up, while the dealer has one card face up. Your aim is to beat the dealer by getting to 21 or nearest without going over. The dealer must stand on 17 and take a card if he has 16 or lower. If your total matches the dealers total you neither win nor lose. If you beat the dealers total you win even money. If you obtain a blackjack (10 + Ace) you are paid one and a half times the stake. However if the dealer also has blackjack it is a standoff. An ace equals one or eleven and all the picture cards equal 10.



Texas Hold Em

Texas Hold Em is the most popular form of poker played worldwide. Players start with an equal amount of chips. The dealer deals two cards to each player and the betting commences after the blinds have been posted. The player to the left of the big blind either calls (bets the big blind) or raises, and each player in turn has the same option.

After the first round of betting is finished the flop is revealed, which are three cards called community cards. The betting commences again, where you have the option of checking, betting or raising. If someone raises you either call it, raise it, or fold. The dealer then reveals the next community card called the turn, and betting continues in the same manner. After that round of betting the next community card is revealed which is named the river.

After the final round of betting the winner is decided by the person who can make the best hand out of his two cards and the community cards. There is no obligation for the victor to show his hand if all the other players have folded. In other words you have to pay to see the hand if you think the player is bluffing. The blinds are raised progressively every twenty minutes and players are gradually eliminated when they run out of chips and the player who wins is the one who amasses all the chips.

Caribbean Stud Poker



Place your initial bet for example £5.00 in the box marked 'ante' in return the dealer will deal 5 cards face down.

The dealer will also have 5 cards with one card face upwards.

After looking at your cards you need to decide whether your hand is good enough to raise a bet. If you decide to 'fold' you lose your initial £5.00 ante bet.

If you think you can beat the dealer's hand you place your cards face down in the 'raise box' and you must place a further bet which must be double your ante, in this case £10 no more or less than double.

The dealer will show you their other four cards. If the dealer does not Qualify with an Ace King (the lowest qualifying hand) they will pay out even money on your ante bet without disclosing your hand.

If the dealer has Ace King or higher they will compare your hand to theirs, if theirs is better you will lose your ante and your raise bet. If you have a better hand you will be paid even money on your initial ante bet and a bonus payment on your raise, depending on what the odds of your hand pay, i.e 2 pairs would pay 2 to 1 on your raise so for a £10 raise you would receive £20 on the raise and £5 on the ante.



Dice/Craps



Dice (Craps) is a fast and exciting game to play. Each player takes a turn of throwing the dice. When the shooter is on a roll he keeps the dice until he fails to make his point. The dice then move to the left of the player, who is the new shooter. The first roll from the shooter is known as the come out roll. The shooter must make a bet on the pass or don't pass line. The pass bet wins when the come out roll is 7 or 11, and loses if it is craps 2, 3 or 12. If the roll is 4,5,6,8,9,10 which would be the point, and you would then win if you make that point before a 7 is rolled.

Come Bets

A Come Bet is placed in the large area marked "Come". A Come Bet works the same way as a Pass Line bet, but it is made after a Pass Line bet. In other words, you can only make a Pass Line Bet on a Come Out roll. However, if you want to continue to make a Pass Line type bet after a point has been established, then you place your bet in the Come area. Just like a Pass Line bet, a Come Bet wins on a roll of 7 or 11 and loses on 2, 3 or 12. If any other number is rolled (4, 5, 6, 8, 9 or 10), the dealer moves the Come Bet to that number on the layout. If that number is rolled again before a 7 is rolled, the Come Bet wins, but if a 7 is rolled first, it loses. So you see, a Come Bet is the exact same thing as a Pass Line bet except it is made after a point has been established.

It also pays even money like a Pass Line bet. Pass Line bets and Come bets are said to be "contract bets" which means that once you make those bets you cannot pick them up.

You are under contract to leave that bet on the table until it is either won or lost.

Field Bets

There is a huge area on the layout between the Come area and the Don't Pass Line marked "Field". This is a one roll bet that covers the 2, 3, 4, 9, 10, 11 and 12. If any of those numbers hit on the next roll after you place your Field bet, you win. A winning Field bet pays even money except for the two and the twelve which pay double.



FUNDRAISING

Fun casinos are a perfect means for Charity and Fundraising events. It offers great entertainment, while raising money for your chosen cause. There's no better way to capture the sensation of gambling without actually losing any money! They will charge you a set fee to provide casino entertainment for you and your guests. You can then charge an entrance fee that covers the casino hire costs. You can then include a fun casino voucher that will entitle each guest to some free casino chips to get them started. Once they have spent their free casino chips, they can then purchase more from one of your nominated members. Some local businesses will sponsor charity evenings. They can do this by sponsoring a casino table. In return they can promote their company name on the casino table, and in addition they could have personalised fun money, which would incorporate the company logo.

WEDDINGS

Weddings are an ideal event where a fun casino can be employed. After all the speeches have been done and the guests are at a bit of a loose end, that is when the fun can start i.e. a fun casino.
